<u>PSHE</u>

Our first PSHE topic of the year is 'Families and Relationships'. We will learn that families are varied and differences must be respected; understand physical and emotional boundaries in friendships; explore the roles of bully, victim and bystander; recognise how our behaviour can affect others and know how to behave in different situations; and learn about bereavement.

<u>Art/DT</u>

Our topic, Drawing: I need space, focuses on understanding retrofuturism, developing skills in evaluating images and creating art through various drawing processes, including collagraph printmaking. It emphasises the development of independent artistic skills and how to generate, test and refine ideas in sketchbooks, leading to a final piece of artwork.

Computing

We will be recognising the importance of staying safe whilst online and gain a greater understanding of what the internet is and how it differs to the 'World Wide Web'.

<u>Music</u>

Our learning in Music this term is focused around the song 'Livin' on a Prayer'. We will learn and build on our knowledge and understanding about the interrelated dimensions of music; and listen and appraise other classic rock songs. Scorpions Curriculum Term 1



<u>Maths</u>

In Maths lessons, we will be revising our knowledge of place value of numbers up to 1 million (Y5) and 10 million (Y6) and apply our understanding to new concepts. We will also be working on our accuracy of written methods for the four operations: addition, subtraction, multiplication and division.

English

Our writing this term focuses on the book 'The Darkest Dark' by Chris Hadfield. We will explore who Chris Hadfield is to create a biography. In our guided reading lessons, we will be exploring non-fiction texts about Space to

develop our skills of vocabulary understanding, inference, prediction, retrieval, summarising and explain.

<u>RE</u>

We will be exploring 'Why do people have to stand up for what they believe in?' in our RE lessons to recognise that people have different beliefs and recognise the importance of religious freedom.

History

This term, we will be finding out what the census can tell us about our local area. We will find out the type of information the census gives about people, make inferences from the past and identify changes between periods of time. We will consider the thoughts and feelings of a Victorian working child whilst learning about the life of Mary Bucktrout.

<u>Science</u>

In our Science lessons, we will be learning about Earth and Space. We will explore different theories and models of our solar system; discover more about the moon; recognise the causes of day and night and the seasons; explore the use of a sundial for measuring time; and recognise the uses of satellites.

<u>PE</u>

In PE this term, we will be developing our skills in Gymnastics. We will also be developing our knowledge and skills whilst playing football.

French

In French, we will be learning to describe ourselves, our friends and our personality traits.
