

PSHE

This term our PSHE topic is 'Healthy Me'. We will understand our own responsibilities for our health and well-being; know about different types of drugs and their effects on the body; understand what is meant by exploitation; know why some people join gangs and the risks this involves; explore people's attitudes towards mental health; and recognise stress and triggers that cause this.

Art

Our Art this term will link to our Geography. Our topic teaches children about the **Inuit** way of life, including some of their cultural and artistic traditions. We will explore the artistic techniques of carving and printing.

Computing

In our computing lessons, we will continue using **Scratch** to explore sequences to extend our knowledge of simple rule-based algorithms. We will be doing some code breaking!

Music

In our music lessons, we will learn new musical skills/concepts and revisit them over time with increasing depth and confidence.

Maths

In our Maths lessons, Year 5 will start with some revision of multiplication and fractions whilst Year 6 begin to understand ratio.

We will then move on to working with decimals and percentages. We will recognise and apply our understanding of equivalent fractions, decimals and percentages. Year 6 will find percentages of amounts.

English

Our writing this term focuses on the book 'Arthur and the Golden Rope'. We will explore what makes a good mythical story in order to write our own myths.

In our guided reading lessons, we will be reading 'Odd and the Frozen Giant' by Neil Gaiman. We will develop our skills of vocabulary understanding, inference, prediction, retrieval, summarising and make connections between stories.

RE

Our RE this term will look at the question 'What does it mean to be a Muslim in Britain today?'

Geography

This term, our topic is 'Frozen Kingdoms'. We will learn about the characteristics and features of polar regions, including the North and South Poles, and include a detailed exploration of the environmental factors that shape and influence them.

Science

'Living Things and Their Habitats' is our Science topic this term. We will explore the life cycles of different mammals, amphibians, insects and birds and use our understanding to describe the life process of reproduction in some animals and plants.

We will move onto describe how living things are classified and understand the reasons for classifying plants and animals.

PE

In PE this term, we will be developing our basketball skills when playing as part of a team in a game. We will also be developing our knowledge and skills whilst playing hockey.

French

We will continue to develop our vocabulary in French and make grammatical connections between French and English.
